Nau Côclea artists residency open call for applications 2019

Artists, performers, curators and writers are invited to apply for a residence at the Contemporary Art Center Nau Côclea

Eligible periods and art disciplines

Residency is offered from May 12th to june June 20th and from September 16th to December 31st 2019. Applications are open for visual arts, live arts, dance, sound art, music, curating and literary projects.

Accommodation and resources

Residency includes accomodation of artists (up to 4 people) in a house with two double bedrooms, kitchenette, bathroom and a living room with a wood stove. Exhibition/rehersal hall (80m²) is also available. Residents can use a video projector, sound equipment, etc. The house is located in Camallera, Catalonia and surrounded by fields and forests.

Nau Côclea staff will introduce artists to the surroundings, locals, and help to find the best local services and material providers if needed.

The minimum length of stay in the residency is 7 days and the maximum is 90 days.

Fees

Artists will pay a fee depending on the number of residents and days of residence:

1 resident 5€ per day 2 residents 10€ per day 3 or 4 residents 15€ per day

Applicants can also apply to exchange the fees for a presentation or performance of the project. This exchange depends on the scheduled possibilities of the center.

Residency does not cover traveling or food expenses and does not include health insurance. It is mandatory for artists to have a health insurance during the stay.

Submission of applications

Applications can be submitted **up to February 28th** Selected artists will be published on March 1st. 2019.

Artists must send a document (PDF or Word) via email to <u>resident@naucoclea.com</u>, document and e-mail title must include the name of the project leader. Application must include the following:

- 1. Contact information of the project leader.
- 2. Number of people that will stay in the residency.
- 3. Prefered dates for the residency and alternative options (if any). If your dates are flexible or you have alternative options your application is more likely to be accepted.
- 4. A letter in which the artist is explicitly committed to make the residence in the selected period and according to the conditions of this call.
- 5. Spaces needed (accommodation house / work hall / outdoors)
- 6. A description of the project including a feedback proposal (maximum 3 pages and links)
- 7. A brief CV (maximum 1 page) and a portfolio of recent art projects or webpage.

After receiving the application we will send a confirmation letter. Please contact resident@naucoclea.com if you do not receive a confirmation letter in the next 5 days.

Jury and selection process

The residencies are granted according to the following criteria:

- Artistic value
- consistency of the project.
- Potential of the project to be shared with different audiences.

Walter Benjamin Grant awarded artists will have a priority in the choice of dates. For more information, please see the specific rules of the grant.
